Thank you for your request environmental information. We appreciate your interest, and we want to let you know that your request has been carefully considered in accordance with the Environmental Information Regulations (EIR).

Environmental Compliance History:

- 1. Could you provide details of any **environmental compliance actions, breaches, or permit variations** related to Cleator WwTW since **2012**?
- 2. Please include any **enforcement actions or fines** issued by the **Environment Agency** or any other regulatory body.
- As our management systems only record back as far as 2013, we can only provide the data from that time. However, we can confirm that there have been 5 instances to report:-
 - Operator self-monitoring sample exceedance on <u>01/03/2013</u>, to which we received a letter from the Environment Agency on <u>29/05/2014</u>.
 - Self-reported pollution incident and permit breach on <u>09/09/2016</u> due to a power failure, Compliance Assessment Report (CAR) received from the Environment Agency <u>27/09/2016</u>. This incident resulted in a contravention of the permit conditions. Specifically, the Flow to Full Treatment, which was not being achieved.
 - Self- reported incident on 16/12/2019 due to an equipment failure, Compliance
 Assessment Report (CAR) received from the Environment Agency on 29/01/2020.
 The EA assessed the 72hr report for this self-reported incident and were satisfied with the measures detailed to address the issue going forward.
 - Works outfall inspection on <u>16/02/2022</u> due to an equipment failure, Compliance
 Assessment Report (CAR) received from the Environment Agency on <u>28/02/2022</u>. No
 further action was required as permit already brought back into compliance.
 - Operator self-monitoring inspection on <u>11/01/2024</u>, to which a Compliance Assessment Report (CAR) was received from the Environment Agency on <u>20/03/2024</u>. No further action was required as permit already brought back into compliance.

Current Treatment Capacity and Performance:

- 1. Can you confirm the **current capacity of Cleator WwTW** and whether it is **operating within its permit limits**?
- 2. Are there any known capacity constraints that could affect its ability to accommodate

additional wastewater flows from **new developments in Cleator Moor**?

- We have had it confirmed from the operational team at the site that the wastewater
 treatment works at Cleator is currently operating fully within its current capacity and
 operational limits. The following link to the Environment Agency website will allow you to
 download and view the current discharge consent permit for Cleator WwTW (<u>View</u>
 registration NW/017470025/010). Specifically, pages 16-20 will show you the emissions
 and monitoring, including the chemical requirements of the site.
- Having liaised with the operational team for this site, they have advised that there are not
 any known capacity constraints that could affect its ability to accommodate additional
 flows from any new developments.

Planned Upgrades or Reinforcements:

- 1. Are there any **planned or ongoing upgrades** to Cleator WwTW to address capacity or compliance issues?
- 2. If so, could you provide a timeline or scope of these improvements?
- We have liaised with the wider business, specifically the operational team for this site, who have confirmed that as it stands there are no current planned upgrades or reinforcements at Cleator WwTW within this current Asset Management Period (AMP).
