Thank you for your request for water quality sample information. We appreciate your interest, and we want to let you know that your request has been carefully considered in accordance with the Environmental Information Regulations (EIR).

Please see attached a copy of the water quality sample data titled 'Appendix 1', for water supply zone ("WSZ") 040. This includes:

- The sample date and time
- The sample location
- The determinand analysed for
- The result and qualifier (whether it is greater than or less than the limit of detection)

For context, all laboratory methods have a Limit of Detection (LOD). This means that the method cannot read lower than a certain value. Any results marked as less than the LOD means that the result is lower than the lowest quantifiable value that the method can detect. In this dataset, results less than the LOD are marked '<'.

I can also confirm that there have been no exceedances over the last 12 months.
